Parent Bible Lesson 1: "God's Creation: The Amazing Universe"

- Genesis 1:1: "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth."

Objective: To teach children about God's creation of the universe and the marvels of space.

Materials:

- A small globe or world map
- Pictures or videos showcasing the beauty of space and celestial bodies

Scientific Object Lesson: Take the globe or world map and explain to your child that God created the entire universe, including our planet Earth. Show pictures or videos of stars, planets, and galaxies to emphasize the vastness and beauty of space.



Script:

Parent: "That's right! God's creation is vast and full of wonders. Let's look at some pictures or videos of stars, planets, and galaxies to see just how amazing the universe is. Can you imagine how powerful and creative God must be to create all of this?"

Here are daily biblical questions for each day of the week for the lesson "God's Creation: The Amazing Universe":

Day 1:

- Question: What did God create in the beginning?
- Discussion: Discuss Genesis 1:1 and reflect on how God created the heavens and the Earth as the starting point of His creation.

Day 2:

- Question: What are some examples of celestial bodies in the universe?
- Discussion: Explore pictures or videos showcasing stars, planets, galaxies, and other celestial bodies. Talk about their beauty and vastness as part of God's amazing creation.

Day 3:

- Question: How does the size and complexity of the universe show God's power and creativity?
- Discussion: Reflect on the immense scale and intricacy of the universe and how it reflects God's greatness and intelligence as the Creator.

**Day 4:**

- Question: How can we appreciate and take care of God's creation, including the universe?
- Discussion: Discuss the importance of being good stewards of the Earth and the universe, taking care of the environment, and being mindful of our impact on God's creation.

Day 5:

- Question: What are some ways we can enjoy and learn more about the universe and its wonders?
- Discussion: Brainstorm activities such as stargazing, visiting planetariums, watching educational documentaries, or reading books about astronomy to further explore and appreciate God's creation.

Day 6:

- Question: How does studying the universe deepen our understanding of God's greatness and love?
- Discussion: Reflect on how learning about the universe and its wonders can inspire awe, gratitude, and a deeper appreciation for God's power and love as the Creator.

Day 7:

- Question: How does the vastness and beauty of the universe remind us of God's presence and care in our lives?
- Discussion: Discuss how the immensity and beauty of the universe can point us to God's majesty, His constant presence, and His love for us as His cherished creation.

Feel free to adapt these questions and discussions based on your child's age and understanding.
